We are happy to, again, organise international XCO UCI competitions at the VAM berg in Drenthe again. This year it will be a class 2 competition for the Elite/U23 and Junior (U19) category, both female and male.

These competitions are combined with a U17 category and with the dutch national youth competition (LJC). The UCI categories and the U 17 are held on Sunday 30th April, the younger youth (LJC) at Saturday 29th April. On Saturday there is a possibility for track exploration for the U17 and UCI categories

The VAM berg is an excellent location for XCO competition events. The ambitions of the organization is to organize international Mountainbike events on a high level as possible

Races for the Elite/U23 (M/W) and U19 (M/W) will be held under the auspices of the UCI, all other races under the auspices of the Royal Dutch Cycling Union (KNWU).

5. Registration procedure, distribution of race numbers, parking event area.

Each rider that wants to compete has to sign in for their presence at least one hour for their start at the registration desk. Riders who ride their first 3 Nations Cup competition of 2023 can pick up their racenumbers at the registration desk.

For youth, their bike check will also be near registration.

Parking is in the blue area's in the eventmap underneath. DO NOT PARK SOMEWHERE ELSE, THIS WILL HARM ORGANISING AT THE VAM BERG IN THE FUTURE.

Parcours 3 Nationscup:




Startclimb 3 Nationscup(only for start):



Additional information of the course:

The course of the 3 nationscup contains choice lines in a number of places. Here the riders can choose from two driving lines, these are indicated with the letters A and B. The A-line is the fastest but also the most difficult, the B-line is easier, but will cost some time.



7. Detailed information of start and finish, timing hot spots (intermediates, speed trap)

There is one timing hot spot MyLaps mat at the finish line for Mylaps transponders.

8. Award ceremonies, Anti-doping tests, race office, press conference room, race meeting room.

The registration area is the centre of the event: Food and drinks in a separate tent, award ceremonies will be held outside near the finishline, anti-doping tests. Race meetings with the commissaires will be in the jurybus located at the finish line.

9. Time-keeping information

Time-keeping will be done with transponders of Mylaps transponder. Riders who don't have a Mylapse transponder can rent one of the KNWU, the costs are E 10,-.

10. Feed/Technical Assistance zones

There are two feed/tech zones. Each rider gets two wristbands for his or her mechanics/assistants. Only with this wristbands it is allowed to enter the feed/techzones. Riders who are helped by people in the feed/techzone without wristband can be disqualified.

11. Parking locations teams, riders, campers

Parking is only allowed in the blue Parking zones as shown under point 6. Parking somewhere else harms organizing at this location in the future.

The team and camper area is only for those who have booked and paid for upfront via www.mtbfestival.nl
